7:30 Comments from Sacred Heart Representative(s)- From Teresa: Some SH parishioners have students attend ICS. SH parishioners have questions about ensuring whether full stewardship is met. IC parishioners must return commitment form by January 2021. Letter to households more than 50% behind in stewardship commitment. It's based on trust and cooperation to ensure commitments meant. May send quarterly updates next year. Some SH parents have not tithed to SH. SH pays some of tuition to ICS in addition to parents paying tuition. Cost of education per student \$5700—charge to non-parishioners. Diocese policy is that parish pays 80% of cost to send student to another parish school. [Do I have that right?] Diocese may reconsider policy as it is costly for the small parishes to cover these costs.

Other issue at SH is how to handle Christmas holiday masses. Lock parish doors 10 minutes after mass has begun. May leave door open b/c some have arrived late and could not get in. Will lock for Christmas mass.

Keith will help John. Tell finance council in Dec mtg. Non ordinary income \$407,000 from government for CARES. Should we give 2% of that amount to Stewardship of Charity as well. The charities are suffering during these times as well. Usually consider Sunday collections in sharing. We've given 5% to Trooper Hopkins' family and for natural disaster emergencies. Get finance council input. Fistula? Charity. Mary Olssen brought it up. More people will get information and learn about new groups.

Dave Bodinet question. Are parents and grandparents allowed to attend ICS mass with students? Two pews on either side are reserved for adults who do not have students. If a child is reading or serving, a parent is allowed to attend with child. No policy announced. It's about numbers. Two parents for each first grader. Have not discouraged grandparents. Encourage virtual. Nick Whelan watched mass from Middle East. Two First Reconciliation celebrations to keep attendance under 100. Only people in same household could attend. Both

under 100 people. Just show up. If every one sought to attend it would get overcrowded. Fr Carl has not turned any one away yet!
