- 1. School Board Report
 - Soccer season started

Staff Reports

- 1. Pastor's Report Fr. Carl Scherrer
 - CSMA: As of Sept. 20, 275 participants, up from 231 last year. Have pledges totaling \$48,175 toward financial target of \$49,650, though focus has been on number of participants, not dollar amounts.
 - The search for a priest residence continues. He has received questions as to why we are not building onsite. The Bishop asked that we not build a "rectory" building. Some reasons for

looking offsite include the trend toward not "living above the store", and that parish partnerships and decrease in number of priests may make it preferable for pastor to live in a neutral site

 - Trunk or Treat coming up nothing new from report
- 3. Finance Report Keith Huels
 - Finance Committee discussed starting up a planned giving program

 - Staying under budget, but have deferred some expenses
 - Mike Kish also mentioned that the CEAC has received an extensive amount in "in-kind" donations through the work donated by parishioners
