- 1. Pastor's Report January 17, 2019 at 7 p.m. will have a summary of the trip to Guatemala. New priest residence is almost completely furnished thanks to the family of a parishioner who recently passed away. Good crowd at the Thanksgiving Eve Service. We hosted it this year. Time/Talent/Treasure forms were sent out two weeks ago. Father Moore who was a pastor in Southern Illinois has been diagnosed with Stage 4 Lung Cancer. Parishioners will be receiving postcards updating everyone on church schedule throughout the months of December and January. We will be giving out the Matthew Kelly books this season. Blue books are in the pews for people to take home with them.
