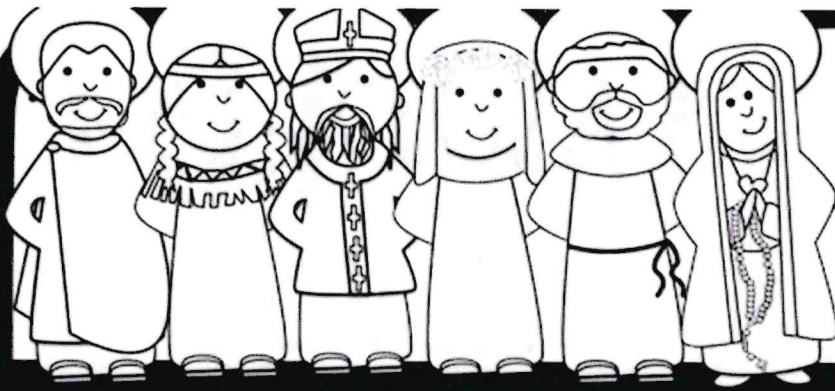
Reminders
