What Are We Learning?

- 5th This week we did an introduction to The Rosary since Oct. 7 is the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary. We watched a kids video about the children of Fatima and made Rosary prayer books.
- 1st On 10/4/23 we covered Chapter 3, Made to Care. We discussed God's creation of all things and that we are the caretakers. We talked about the Holy Trinity in advance of the 10/11 class. And we started learning the Glory Be.
- 3rd We continued our talk on Adam and Eve and Cain and Abel. Cain killed Abel. Our focus was on anger and how we can deal with this emotion. Do you think Jesus got angry? 3rd graders know!
- 8th Grade is taking a deep dive into what it means to be members of the Church, and what role individuals have to play in being the Body of Christ. We are also doing some soul-searching, deciding what it means to continue in the faith after the last Sacrament of Initiation.

Philippians 4:6-9

Matthew 21:33-43
