Faith Reflection

January 28, 2024
Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time
Deuteronomy 18:15-20
1 Corinthians 7:32-35
Mark 1:21-28

We gathered Sunday as the Body of Christ to nourish ourselves both at the Table of the Eucharist and the Table of the Word. Our scriptures described what it means to speak with authority, and recognize authority when it speaks. The Old Testament shows time and again that prophets, who spoke with the authority of God, were not recognized "in their own land." In our Gospel passage, people are astonished that Jesus speaks with authority, yet even unclean spirits recognize him as the Messiah. We pray to listen carefully for those times in our lives when God is using circumstances or people to speak to us with authority, so that we may act with faith.
