
Reminders

Faith Reflection

Sunday, March 10, 2024 The Fourth Sunday of Lent 1 Samuel 16:1b,6-7,10-13a Ephesians 5:8-14 John 9:1-41

In the Gospel account on the Fourth Sunday of Lent, the story of the man born blind, we watch as Jesus ministers to someone who faces both disability and abandonment, and he does so on the Sabbath, to the aggravation of the Pharisees. As we seek to be imitators of Christ, we must discern who has been placed in our path requiring our care and compassion regardless of our own discomfort, inconvenience or social stigma. Those who are baptized in Christ must be willing to listen to God when his whispers arge us to challenging ministry.
