
Reminders

Wisdom 7:7-11

Hebrews 4:12-13

Mark 10:17-30

In today's readings, we are challenged to put God over all earthly things, including any wealth we have accumulated, or objects or ideas that we use to wield power over each other. God calls us to different places in our lives, spiritual as well as physical, that may take us far from our family and friends. In preparation for this separation, which may even be painful, Jesus reminds us to pack lightly, keeping only what we need to find our way back to God.
